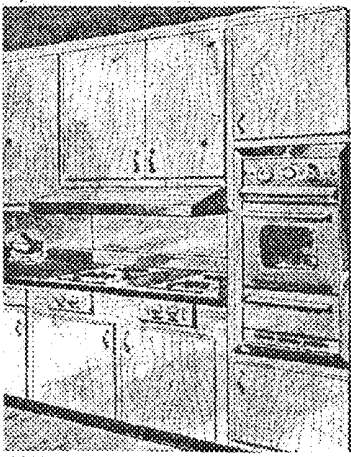

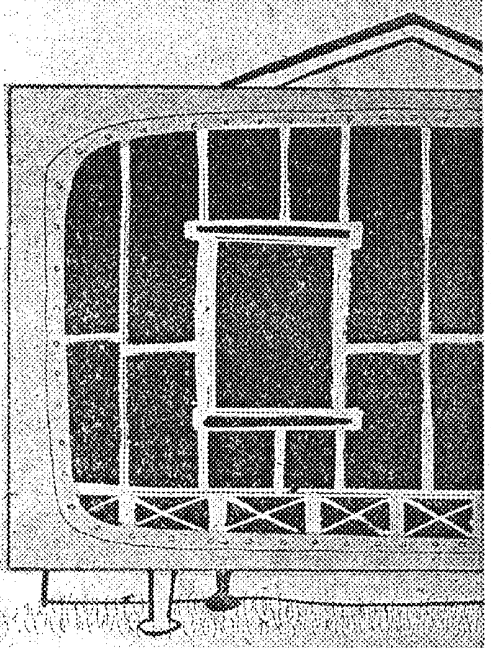
One way to expand a home
