15 things, you know, we needed to make sure the towels
16 were clean and washing and get to the pharmacy, get
17 the medication, get the new type of medication.

18 You know, bring the food to him. Sometimes
19 he wouldn't eat. Sometimes he would eat. Sometimes
20 he would eat strange hours.
