Complying with your request, I looked at competitive bags used for spray on acoustical plaster:

U. S. G. is a glued end valve bag.

National is an open mouth bag.

You asked me to find out if our spray on acoustical plaster can be bagged in valve bags and the only way I know to find out is to try it. Therefore will Mr. Read clean out one of his mixer packer assemblies, mix up a small charge of the spray on acoustical plaster and see if it will pack in valve bags through the packer. Please advise results and opinion as to feasibility of the method. If it will work, the labor costs of packing should be much lower.
