Any and all employment and medical records of Thomas Johnson; all invoices, purchase orders or other documents evidencing purchases of asbestos, asbestos products or products containing asbestos by Westinghouse from 1950 through December 1976, together with any and all catalogue or product numbers or codes identifying the products; any and all insulation blanket assembly blueprints or similar blueprints incorporating asbestos insulation for gas turbine engines #171, #191, #301, #251, #501, and any and all other prints for gas or steam turbine engines worked on by Thomas Johnson from 1951 through December 1976; any and all booklets, pamphlets or other documents prepared by or on behalf of Westinghouse depicting the gas and/or steam turbine engines on which Thomas Johnson worked; any and all reports, studies, tests or other memoranda relating to asbestos dust samplings in the plant or portions thereof wherein Thomas Johnson was employed from 1951 through 1976; any and all tests or studies and results thereof performed by or on behalf of Westinghouse between 1951 and 1976 designed to minimize or eliminate the inhalation of asbestos dust and fibers; any and all studies and results thereof performed by or on behalf of Westinghouse between 1951 and 1976 concerning the effect of asbestos fibers on the lungs and physical condition of persons, such as Thomas Johnson, due to inhalation of asbestos dust or fibers by one using or being exposed to such dust or fibers.

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
