MULTIWALL BAG SPECIFICATION

The attached multiwall bag specifications are offered for your comment prior to inclusion in the Group I Package Specification Book. These are standard-form versions of previous purchase specifications and conversations with King City plant personnel.

All bags must bear the following precautionary labeling:

WARNING: BREATHING DUST MAY BE HARMFUL
Do not breathe dust.



This warning statement should be printed on the front panel of the bag in the open space below the word asbestos in letters at least 3/4 inch high. The caution statement, "Do not breathe dust", may be smaller and be both upper and lower case.

This should be on every bag.

The plain unprinted bags should have this minimum printing on one face:
