Dear George,

Here are several matters for your attention.

Will you please return the Bag Packer System tracings, either directly to me, or to John Russell in order that I might make revisions to them. In the Wheelabrator System which will no longer serve its present purpose when the new system is installed, there are two branches coming from the bag packer bin and the elevator. I want to add those into the Bag Packer System since they are really part of that operation. I also want to substitute rotary air locks on the bottom of the Flex-Kleen collector and on the bottom of the primary cyclone. When I made the last change there was an increase in static suction which Dustex cannot assure me will operate satisfactorily due to the lightness of material in combination with the new static condition. There is no wisdom in gambling, so I want to install airlocks.

The new system which I am now engineering, will be ready in a few days. Instead of sending you the tracings for submitting prints to Industrial Hygiene, I plan to send you copies and to hold the tracings until the installation is completed. Will this be OK with your office.

I thought you ought to be made aware of these conditions in regard to the new system. The collector will be 84 ft. long (Flex-Kleen 84 UDC 288). Its delivery will be about 10 weeks after ordering. The exhauster, a WY Blower #502, will have a delivery of seventeen weeks. If a Buffalo Forge Exhauster were substituted, the delivery would be on the order of six weeks. These deliveries may be important when a decision is made to proceed with the installation.

John and I talked about sending you preliminary prints for your review before sending the series, but time may not allow this delay. I do plan to go out to see Bill Hammer as soon as he has completed the drawings, even before checking, to give him an opportunity to review the design. Is this delay going to put more pressure on you by the pollution agency?

A quick word from you will be appreciated. SGP 0006845
