Subject: Action Items from 9/16 C-8 Sampling Meeting

1. Data analysis of Nichols' C-8 sampling project
 Develop format for data entry GAC
 Have data entered RRM
 Analyze Data GAC
2. Insure proper PPE is used in the FP/Disp. Wax Room CJG
3. Reduce C-8 exposure risk from Granular ingredients hood
 Implement short-term measures (fix leak, etc.) CJG
 Implement long-term measures (surfactant addition system) RJZ
4. Work with Hailey to move B162 2nd floor smoking area RRM
5. Install filter on FP dryer C-8 vent RJZ
6. Insure proper maintenance is performed on FP dryer as
 noted in incident investigation FDL 970015 See
 Write Up
7. Set standard in the BTO to not wear clothes contaminated
 with dispersion (or other C-8 containing materials) RRM
8. Resolve exposure potential associated with draining of
 FP float tank (automated valve?) CJG/RJZ
9. Insure proper PPE is used for changing air filters with
 emphasis on the roof of B162. CJG
10. Manage C-8 exposure potential in vicinity of C-8 scrubber
 Understand C-8 exposure potential on B162 roof &
 surrounding areas RJZ
 Institute appropriate administrative controls & PPE CJG
 Take additional air samples to complete mapping AJP/BSO
11. Compare Nichols' data with previous data (particularly
 blood data) and look for correlations AJP
12. Take wipe samples in FEP clean room. BSD
13. If C-8 is going to continue to be used in FEP, investigate
 engineering controls on C-8 levels. By Loch
14. Evaluate Nichols' data and recommend additional sampling
 needs. BSD

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
