ASBESTOS - LABELING PLASTIC AND PLASTIC GUN CEMENT SACKS

J. E. Toomey, at the request of Jim Parker, advises a Federal Regulation went into effect July 7, 1972 requiring labeling of asbestos-containing products. For this reason he urges immediate compliance for any Kaiser cements containing asbestos. He advises, "The caution label should be applied by stencil, stamps, stickers, or whatever may be the most convenient means for prompt compliance." The label shall state:

CAUTION

Contains Asbestos Fibers
Avoid Creating Dust
Breathing Asbestos Dust May Cause
Serious Bodily Harm

Immediately below the label but not necessarily in lettering of the same size, insert "Above label is in compliance with Federal Regulations relating to Occupational, Safety, and Health Standards, 29 CFR 1910.93a."
