Dear Mr. Kohr:

I am sending you, somewhat tardily I fear, a statement of the cost of the conduct of the work carried out by us on behalf of your company during the past year.

The principal reason for not sending this sooner was that there was some discussion being carried out on a matter of whether more work should be done in the appraisal of the situation in the Varnish Works. We do not seem to have arrived at complete agreement with your people on the significance of certain of the results obtained, but I take it that Mr. Fasig and his associates are satisfied that no more work is required in that direction.

I should call your attention to one matter which may be of significance. In connection with a number of our observations, specifically certain air analyses designed to measure the lead exposure, we suggested that observations might well be made during cold weather in order to establish their severity under the worst conditions. If this is to be done this year, it will have to be done soon. Consequently I call it to your attention and will be prepared to be guided entirely by your wishes in the matter. We do not believe that any very considerable amount of work is necessary to establish the facts.
