Re: Angiosarcoma Register Update

Dear Ms. Hamelton,

I wish to provide you with an update on the status of several angiosarcoma cases. The first case is United States Case Number 33 from Plant 1. Date of birth . This man died in November, 1996. The cause of death was unrelated to angiosarcoma. As far as we know, there was no recurrence of the condition during his life. The University of Louisville has not yet received a copy of the death certificate.

There are four new cases to report. Three are from Plant 1 (Louisville) and the other from Plant 5 (Avon Lake). I have presented the information in the format previously used in the Register.
