I have been slow in replying to your letter of July 2nd on the subject of DuPont's "Tank Talk". I am inclined to agree with Ethyl Corporation's view that this was a clever and useful method on the part of DuPont from a purely commercial point of view. However, I do not consider that it is necessary to do anything to counter it.

We were very interested in your information regarding the use of gas masks when handling sludge outside a tank. Up to now we have had no difficulty in enforcing this requirement, and we are inclined to let matters stand as they are. However, should our customers draw our attention to the fact that such equipment is not used in the United States for the purpose, we may have to review the whole matter.
