This is in reference to our discussion yesterday.

I am enclosing a copy of the letter I sent to Selikoff, before I saw you, and this is self explanatory. Simply would like the data recorded in the literature. Since you did the x-rays, you should report the results. This view has also been conveyed to Mr. Kane, that it would be best if you carry out any other efforts at his Local.

I do hope that your conference with Paul Gross turned out satisfactorily and since you decided to consider "Science", you must have gotten some confirmation from Gross about the significance of your data, along the lines I had mentioned to encourage you to publish the essence of your findings.

Now, in regard to Mannheim, I am enclosing the list of cases of asbestosis, recorded as primary or secondary on the death certificate or obtained by further query. This list covers the period 1956-1964, as you requested, because this is the period of your study.

I would appreciate it, if you would reciprocate, since you said that you had a very large number from 1956 of cases of asbestosis from the hospitals of that area. I would like to match your list, with our original cohort, and see what a difference this may make.

I was glad to learn about the progress of your asbestos studies, and I do hope you "get them out" soon. My interest as I mentioned to you, has not extended beyond trying to improve on my one study, by getting a better concept of the relative rates for the cohort.
