Institute Steam Plant
Proposed No. 9 Boiler

In April of this year you quoted our Mr. L. J. Bowditch a price of \$283,422.00 for the installation of No. 9 boiler at our Institute, West Virginia plant. This price was on a delivered and erected basis subject to the usual adjustment of actual erection costs. The quotation covered an exact duplicate of boiler No. 8 except for a change in the pulverizers and coal feeders.

We would like to have you submit to us six copies of a formal quotation on the above work using as a basis the data on which you formulated the price given to Mr. Bowditch supplemented by the following additional items:

1. Two (2) Riley pulverizers No. 450 single ATRITA type equipped with tungsten carbide wearing parts and having an integral dryer and precrusher mounted on the same shaft and in the same casing as the pulverizer proper. I believe this change was included in your verbal quotation to Mr. Bowditch. We propose to provide the motor drives for these pulverizers. Therefore, we require complete specifications since they will presumably be different from the early motors.
2. Each pulverizer shall be served by a drum type floor mounted coal feeder equipped with revolution counter, pocket wipers, etc. These feeders are different from the original ones, but their price is also included in the aforementioned verbal quotation. However, motor characteristics will be changed. Kindly include in your quotation necessary new motors as a part of the feeders. These are direct current motors.
