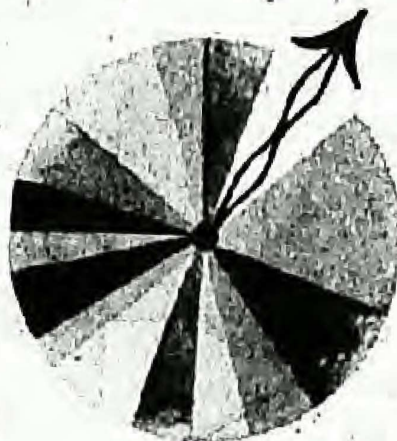
ST. JOHN'S, Newfoundland,
