MINE VENTILATION: Mr. Boyland and Mr. H. Lloyd of the Mines Department called at this office this afternoon to discuss the outcome of Inspector Simmonds' recent ventilation survey. We found the copy of your letter to the Senior Inspector most helpful.

Mr. Boyland intimated that he proposed to visit Wittenoom in conjunction with Mr. Simmonds at the end of this month to check personally on several of the features listed in Mr. Simmonds' report. In this regard, the most important feature appears to be:

- (a) The appointment of a Ventilation Officer.
- (b) A plan of the proposed mine layout incorporating a definite ventilation system.
- (c) The use of auxiliary fan equipment in stopes areas.
