<u>Date</u>	<u>Incident No.</u>	<u>Description</u>
07/12/83	83-09 (Issued)	Recordable Injury--Dept. 16; pipe-fitter suffered a fractured left thumb while removing a 10" valve from a pipeline that runs parallel to the 16D3 structure. His thumb was pinched between the handwheel of a valve handle extension and a support bracket on the handrail. (Mata)
07/18/83	83-10 (Issued)	Near-Miss Incident--Dept. 16; Three pipefitters sustained contusions to the arms and legs when the load chain of a chain fall they were using came loose and struck them. The contusions were minor but the incident raised serious concerns on chain fall usage. (Mata)
07/22/83	83-11 (Not Issued)	Recordable Injury--Dept. 14; PT Technician was sprayed with hot PEB while sampling 14D4 feed. Sustained 1st and 2nd degree burns to left foot. (Wise)
08/12/82	83-12 (Issued)	Recordable Injury--Dept. 15/16; Pipe-fitter cut his left thumb while cutting a plastic "ty-rap". The "ty-rap" was securing 1/2 inch O.D. SS tubing to a 2-1/2" carbon steel pipe. (Wills)
08/15/83	83-13	Cancelled
07/27/83	83-14 (Issued)	Tank Overflow--Dept. 51; NO INJURIES. AN storage tank 51T17-1 overflow.
