With reference to your letter of February 4, 1964. We agreed to accept the reject material which appear as items one through eleven on the attached sheet at 10¢ per square foot. Items one through eleven represent all of the material examined by you on your visit to our Plant.

Also listed, you will find items twelve through twenty-three which indicate those items received since your visit which have similar defects to those on enclosed samples and those examined by you which we will accept on the same basis. We are shipping one-foot-square samples of the various types of defects to the attention of Dr. Dave Baldwin, Engineering Department, Westinghouse Electric Corporation, Hampton, South Carolina per your request.

We will hold items twelve through twenty-three pending your advice as to whether or not they will be offered on the same basis as items one through eleven. Should you care to examine these, they will be available in our Plant. However, we would appreciate your advice in this regard since these items do present a storage problem and cannot be held indefinitely.
