I have your letter of July 24th enclosing correspondence with Dr. Stephenson.

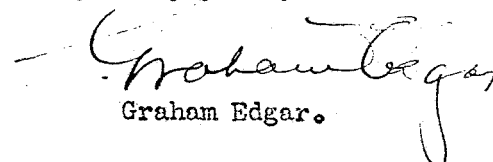
