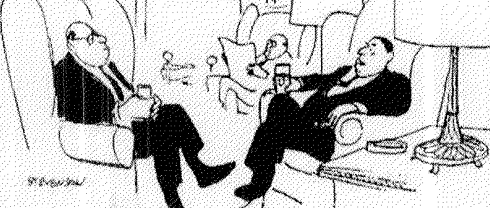


Arne Long (center) discusses progress on the downtown Superior Court project with San Jose mem-

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IF BOND ISSUE PASSES

Buildings Have Big Share

Santa Clara County voters Tuesday will be asked to approve \$5,992,000 for construction of county office and court buildings as a part of the proposed \$31,625,000 county bond issue.

The building program is Measure A of the five-measure bond program and will provide for county buildings at Civic Center and branch centers to gather with facilities for various departments on county-owned property just north of San Jose.

Edmond J. Gale and W. Earl Freitas, San Jose co-chairmen of the Citizens for County Building and Park Bonds, pointed out projects included in the building program are those "essential to keep abreast of the demand for government

services by our growing population."

Major facilities planned for Civic Center are a Registrar of Voters building to cost \$8,600,000, and expansion of the Criminal-Legal building, \$9,000,000. Bond funds in the amount of \$440,000 are earmarked for completion of the downtown Superior Court project.

Also scheduled for construction. If the bonds pass, is a new building in the West Valley Center which serves the Los Gatos-Campbell-Saratoga area. The building will house a second Court Department and branch offices for the Health and Welfare departments. Cost of the project will be \$606,000.

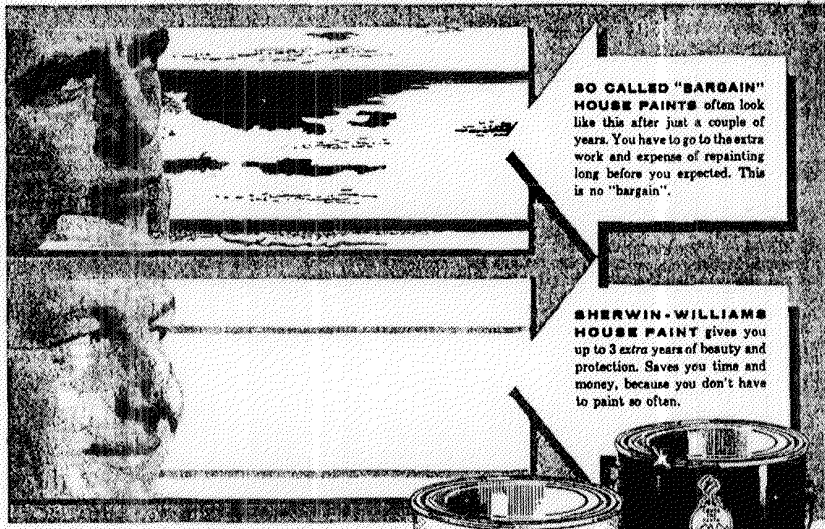
In the North County, additional land will be acquired for future growth of the North

County Center and the fourth floor of the present building will be completed. Bond funds in the amount of \$474,000 will be spent for these projects.

Balance of the Measure A money will be used for the Sunnyvale court building, communications center expansion, and locating departments with an industrial or warehousing requirement on the North San Jose site.

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
