REPORT:

Divorced. Age 39. No children.

HISTORY OF ACCIDENT:

While at work on January 26, 1949 at 4:20 P.M., the patient turned off the motor on the edgerunner, but reached into the container for fiber. The wheel which was still in motion rolled over the fingers of his left hand. He reported to my office on January 26, 1949 at 4:45 P.M.

FINDINGS:

Macerating lacerations across the palmar surface of the left little and ring fingers. Deep laceration over the palmar surface of the proximal interphalangeal articulation of the left middle finger. Deep laceration dorsum of proximal phalanx of left middle finger with multiple abrasions over the dorsum of the fingers. X-ray reveals fractures of the distal phalanges of the left index and middle fingers, distal phalanx and head of the proximal phalanx of the left ring finger, distal and middle phalanges of the left little finger.

TREATMENT:

Areas cleansed, debrided, wounds closed with numerous dermal sutures, hand immobilized with posterior splint, surgically dressed.

DISABILITY:

Length of disability unable to be determined at this time.
