2           Glass slides are about, oh, about two and  
3 three-quarters inches long, three-quarters inches wide  
4 and 16th of an inch thick and they would have a piece  
5 of tissue on it from a person's body, say the pleura  
6 in Mr. Grewe's case, which has been stained by dye so  
7 I could see it through a microscope.

8           What I would do is look at that tissue  
9 through a microscope and determine if there was a  
10 cancer or some other condition present. If there was  
11 a cancer present, I would try to tell what type of  
12 cancer it was.

13           With the paraffin blocks, it is about like  
14 this, say three-quarters by half an inch by about a  
15 quarter of an inch, and that paraffin block contains  
16 the tissue that was taken from the body that has been  
17 processed in a certain way and infiltrated with wax so  
18 we could put it into this machine called a microtome  
19 so we could make very thin slices of it to put on  
20 these slides that we stain with dyes.
