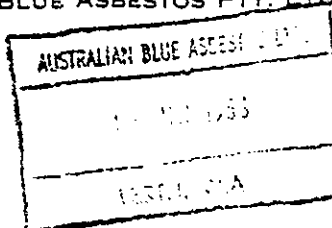

NEW CONTRACTS

We enclose a report from the Assistant Manager referring to the setting of new contracts. These show the basis of calculations for the new prices.

FIBRE SHIPMENT - CHARON

The loading of the special fibre for Flintkote and Certain Teed Products was witnessed on Friday evening. Loading went smoothly and all bags were in good clean condition and properly marked. One bag was torn by a bag hook but we had this repaired. The Wharfinger was not as cooperative as he should have been and a difference of opinion occurred over the number of bags and tonnage to be shipped. He was told that he was to ship 200 bags and 100 bags as instructed by our agent. Mr. Fernihough has promised to telephone you today and give you details. It appears from the weights that the bags would be approximately 1 lb heavy. It is our opinion that the bags left Point Samson in very good condition.
