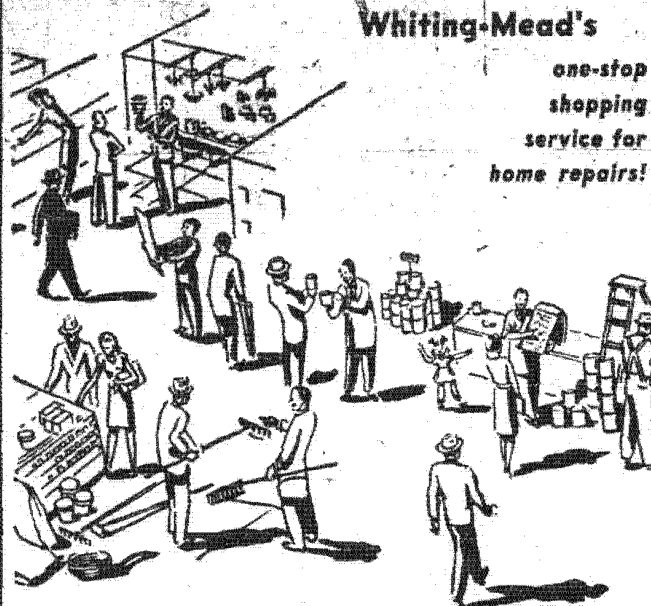

figures are fairly close together, the  
deal will be approved and a loan  
made at 4 percent interest. The  
rate will drop in August, under a  
new regulation, to 3 percent. Maxi-  
mum repayment period is 20 years.  
Payments usually range from \$34 to  
\$44 monthly, depending on size of  
investment.

BOARD SELF-SUPPORTING

Because financiers regard state  
veterans' home bonds as specially  
sound and take them at 2 percent  
and under, the board has from its  
ception 25 years ago been self-sup-  
porting. Its funds are in such good  
shape now that a partial rebate of  
a \$250 administrative charge paid  
by War I men will soon be made,  
Van Schaick said. No such fee is  
levied against veterans of War II.

Plans and specifications of pro-  
posed new homes must be submitted  
to board representatives. Wrapped  
up in the deal is fire insurance and  
a policy on the buyer's life through  
which his wife or other beneficiary  
will automatically acquire full own-  
ership of the home without addi-  
tional payments if he dies.

Van Schaick estimated that more  
than \$100,000,000 will be needed for  
the War II state homes program.  
In the years since War I, \$85,000,  
000 has been used.

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
