\$30,000 to Mother Of Traffic Victim

MERCED, Oct. 6.—Mrs. Rhoda Youngs, 64, mother of a young truck driver killed in a highway accident near here last year, was awarded \$30,000 damages today from Pacific Tank Lines of Los Angeles.

The superior court jury heard testimony that Mrs. Youngs' son, Otis Bingham, 27, was killed when his truck collided with a tanker driven by Shelley L. Mounts, 33, who was on the wrong side of the road. Mounts also was killed.

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
