Today on Climate Beat . . .

. . . we went to Germany, where Chancellor Angela Merkel may be seeking some common ground on climate change at this week's G-20 summit, though it may come at the price of weakening some of the language on climate efforts and the Paris Agreement.

Out on the grid, the Energy Information Administration reports that utility-scale renewable energy surpassed the amount of nuclear generation in the United States in March and April for the first time since 1984, with the agency citing growth in renewables and maintenance of nuclear plants.

And in Congress, House Appropriations Committee Chairman Rodney Frelinghuysen (R-NJ) is facing home-state pressure to reject the Trump administration's proposed budget cuts for EPA in fiscal year 2018 and boost the agency's revenues.
