Dear Mr. Yates:

I am sending you somewhat tardily three copies of a further report which will give you information on experimental work on the centrifugal problem to date. The report is not in the form in which I would like to give it to you, but to put it in proper form would require complete rewriting and this I can not do because I can not take my secretary from some other very necessary work at this time. Moreover, to rewrite the material would necessitate a delay which would defeat the purpose of the revision.

In order to put this material in its proper relationship, I have continued my report according to the style which I first adopted in making up the three reports. You will note by itself a portion of a report which should be attached to my former report to you, headed Part 2 - Methods for the Control of the "x" Content of Chicle and for the Removal of "x" from Chicle. I would like for you to substitute for the original Page 9 of that report, the page which I am now sending to you, adding also Table 7 which I am appending and renumbering the original Table 7 so as to make it Table 8. I am sending you this material in order to supply you with all of the data which properly come under the heading of Part 2 as I originally planned it.

Part 3 is more or less self-explanatory and I believe it can serve as a proper basis for discussion in our conference of next Thursday. It brings the experimental work up to date and will make all of the experimental procedures intelligible. Inasmuch as you will probably revise the whole report before its presentation, this final report of mine merely serves to supply you with the information which we now have, and with the point of view which Themann and myself hold concerning the entire problem.
