

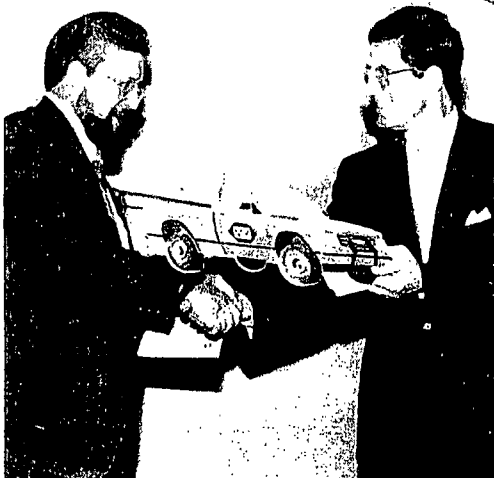


ANNUAL 1987 MEETING
