In the near future we will start to imprint the following message on our Celtemp cartons. It will also be on the KAYLO cartons, both of our manufacture and of CDP's Berlin manufacture:

THIS PRODUCT CONTAINS ASBESTOS FIBER

If dust is created when this product is handled, avoid breathing the dust.

If adequate ventilation control is not possible, wear respirator approved by U.S. Bureau of Mines.

We understand that a statement to this effect is also going to be or is now included on Thermaxcel cartons. The reason for this is that the Legal Departments of the various companies feel that a statement such as this is a necessary precaution and a defense against suits concerning asbestos against manufacturers and contractors. It is no big deal and I don't think we should make any fuss about it, but I think you should mention to your accounts that this statement will be on our cases.
