the measure and which may result in the defeat of the proposition. It is a provision which makes the terms of all elective offices four years.

The representation plan would divide the city into fifteen districts, each Councilman to be elected from one. It is general this is popular and approved at the people's election to the office.

If a vote of 5 to 3, the Council refused to permit the proposition providing for an executive budget to be placed upon the ballot. The Council took the stand that the proposed charter amendment would give the Mayor too much power. While it may be considered that the Council's action was a slap at the Mayor, who favors an executive budget, it is the opinion of many around the City Hall that the blow will be more keenly felt by the several civic organizations who were behind it. They are the Chamber of Commerce, Merchants' and Manufacturers' Association, Municipal League, Central Labor Council and others.

Among other propositions to be voted on at the November election is the initiative ordinance presented months ago by the jitney-hog owners. The ordinance would eliminate the restricted zone, which is bounded by First and Eighth streets and Hill and Main streets. Whether the people should approve the elimination or not the jitney-hog drivers could not operate within the district, the Board of Public Utilities having decreed that jitney-hog operations are essential when they operate on lines parallel to street car systems.

The natural gas ordinance, which would require all companies to supply straight natural gas, also will be voted upon. Whether or not a pension fund shall be created for police and firemen also will be placed upon the ballot.

EXPECT ARREST SOON IN MURDER MYSTERY.

POLICE DECARE KAIN PAINTING CONTRACTOR HAD A WOMAN IN HIS AUTO.

An arrest and a confession are expected within the next forty-eight hours by the authorities in connection with the murder of Frank E. Love, Los Angeles and Long Beach painting contractor, who was shot through the head in his own automobile on Friday night between Los Angeles and Long Beach. That there is one woman in the case, possibly two, has been definitely established. That Love during the evening had as a passenger in his car a woman, not his wife, has also been confirmed, the police assert. A woman was seen to ascend Love near his Los Angeles house on Thirty-eighth street early Friday evening.
