DENVER (P) State and defense attorneys in the murder trial of John Gilbert Graham, 21, picked today for the fifth day today to pick a jury of their particular preference.

Prosecution attorneys were trying to get a 12-member jury dominated by men. Court-appointed lawyers for Graham aimed for a jury weighted with women.

Graham, convicted forger and father of two, is accused of putting in the luggage of his mother Mrs. Daisie E. King, 55, a dynamite bomb that blew up an airliner 11 minutes after taking off from the Denver airport last Nov. 1. Mrs. King and 43 others died in the crash.

Tentative jurors in the box are seven men and six women. All are married. The 13th, a woman at this time, is an alternate who hears the case but takes no part in the verdict unless one of the regulars is excused during the trial.

Six of the seven peremptory challenges exercised by the prosecution removed women from the tentative jury. Each side has 15 challenges to remove prospective jurors without stating the cause.

The seven challenges exercised by the defense have taken men off the tentative jury.

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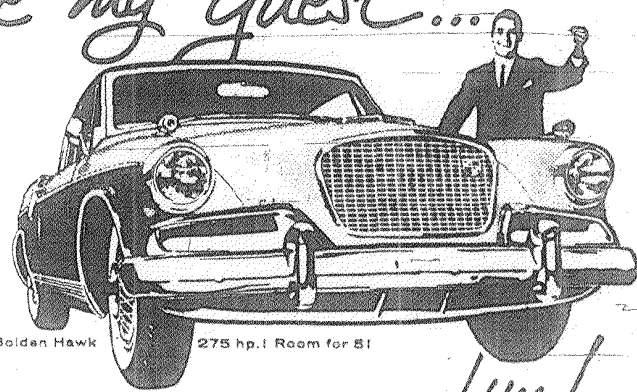
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
