Amy, for attribution to "an EPA spokesperson," please:

EPA is very concerned about the recent reports of crop damage related to the use of dicamba in Missouri, Arkansas and other states.

We are working with the states and the registrants to better understand the issue. We are reviewing the current use restrictions on the labels for these dicamba formulations in light of the incidents that have been reported this year. The underlying causes of the various damage incidents are not yet clear, but EPA is reviewing the available information carefully. We will rely on the best information available to inform our assessment
