Dear Mr. Alsup:

On July 2, 2020, Rio Oil and Gas (Permian) II, LLC ("Rio") entered into an Administrative Compliance Order on Consent ("AOC"), Docket No. CAA-06-2020-3389, with the United States Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") to resolve certain alleged violations of the Texas Administrative Code, which had been adopted into the Texas State Implementation Plan. Pursuant to the AOC, Rio agreed to specific requirements as outlined in paragraph 29 to be completed within 180 days of the AOC Effective Date (i.e., no later than December 29, 2020).

EPA has received and reviewed your final letter report, required under AOC paragraph 29, of all work completed under the AOC, dated July 31, 2020.
