As a follow up to our call on 7 September, we have prepared the attached response document. This document has been jointly drafted by Ahlstrom-Munksjö, H&V and Lydall, and aims at bringing further clarity on the different points raised during our discussion regarding C6-treated filtration media.

Also to note, we used the opportunity of this document to respond to some of the comments submitted to the SEAC consultation by EEB/ClientEarth on the filtration derogation under the PFHxA restriction proposal.

In particular, the attached document covers:

- Why the coalition consists of these three members and only covers C6-treated filtration media
- When do we need glue repellency and how it relates to oil repellency
- Oil repellency tests
- Why ePTFE membranes are not suitable substitutes for C6
- Table summarizing implications (with some quantitative information)

We attach an excel table that lists the scope of applications falling under the derogation request supported by the filtration coalition.

The authorises working on a broad PFAS-restriction proposal have now notified ECHA their intention to prepare a restriction dossier. At the same time we are also launching a second stakeholder consultation that will be open until 19 September.

In the questionnaire, stakeholders can also take part of the results from various studies that we have done and which will form the basis for the proposal. In addition, stakeholders have the opportunity to comment if they think that information is missing.
