Gentlemen:-

BRUSHES:

We acknowledge receipt of your letter S-2150 dated March 16th and note inquiry you received from Sacramento Branch, asking when they could expect shipment of various items on their Eastern order #651 of July 30, 1920.

Upon investigation, we find that the following items were shipped on Dec. 29th, via Steamer "Texan", which sailed from Boston Jan. 1st--E/L #3:--

These items all appear on Whiting-Adams invoice of Dec. 29th, 1920--\$174.91, and we trust this information will enable Sacramento Branch to locate the brushes in question.

Regarding the balance of Pioneer Whitewash and Pioneer Kalsomine Brushes on Sacramento order, as well as the balances due on your orders of Feb. 19th, April 6th May 14th, June 18th and Sept. 18th of last year, beg to state we recently asked Whiting-Adams Co. when they expected to be in a position to complete the balances due on various orders, and received their reply stating that the majority of the items due were Wall Brushes, Whitewash or Kalsomine of the same handles.
