In accordance with our conversation of today the writer telephoned Mr. Zapp who answered "yes" to both questions 1 and 2 which are quoted below.

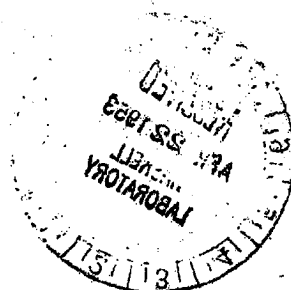
"1. Is it dangerous to leave the Exterior Primer on these fence posts and repaint it with House Paint 40 Outside White?
