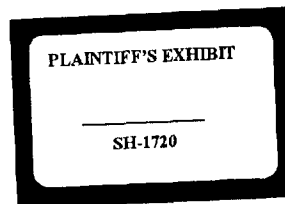

SUBJECT: AUDISCAN TRAINING AID ON "ASBESTOS IN THE WORKPLACE".

We are sending you a copy of a Audiscan Program on "Asbestos In The Workplace" for review and use where and if you believe appropriate.

This program was made in a Shell manufacturing setting, outlining their system of work practices. Although pipeline people are not exposed to the asbestos hazard regularly, there may be occasions where they are; such as, in removing old insulation on pipes or boilers or handling or working materials containing asbestos.
