Item 13122 - FACTORY STOCKS

Sales and Stockkeeping Departments to determine gallonage—if any—in warehouses that can be offered Districts on "ex-quota" basis.

Item 13126 - CARTONS

Mr. Mills to report on supply of second-hand open-head drums at all plants that can be used as shipping containers for smaller packages.

Item 13129 - RAW MATERIALS

Steel Balls for Mills - Mr. Mills to make sure that we have no obsolete stocks of any sizes.

Dehydrol - Mr. Coolidge to follow P C & C to obtain greater sales.

Lithopone - Mr. Mills to check his requirements again and report at next meeting.

Item 13137 - KEM-TONE PRODUCTS

Kem-Tone - Mr. Rinkoski to check on stocks of Kem-Tone in glass containers.

Item 13139 - BALTIMORE WAREHOUSE

Mr. Lemperly to check into Lawrence lease in Washington with the thought that we might move our Baltimore Warehouse to that point.

Item 13140 - COAL-TAR - TWO-GALLON CONTAINERS
