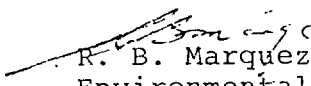
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- (vi) Individual renovations of insulation on piping and equipment.
- (vii) Insulation will be stripped to avoid visible emissions to the outside air, kept wet as needed to avoid dust emissions, bagged or drummed wet, and sealed in leak-tight containers while wet. Containers will be labeled per 61.22 (j) (3) (i) (1).
- (viii) Disposal will be in our own location landfill or in a commercial disposal site approved by the Texas Department of Water Resources. Disposal will be in accordance with paragraph 61.25 (a) or 61.25 (3) (1).
