. . . we went to the Great White North, where Shell has installed a new generation of continuous methane detectors in a natural gas field in Alberta -- a move environmentalists are contrasting with the Trump administration's efforts to roll back Obama-era methane limits for the oil and gas sector.

In Paris Agreement news, Secretary of State Rex Tillerson in a recent memo directed U.S. diplomats to avoid giving specifics to their counterparts about any Trump administration plans to "re-engage" in the global climate deal, which President Donald Trump announced June 1 he would exit.

And in our daily news roundup, we brought news that some typical conservative allies, including the Chamber of Commerce, Koch-backed political groups and many industry groups, are reluctant to back EPA Administrator Scott Pruitt's planned "red-team, blue-team" critique of climate science.
