As discussed during my last visit, effective immediately all asbestos millboard and starch bound asbestos paper will be labeled to meet OSHA requirements. This would be the cut sheets of 211 millboard and Homo Paper which you purchase. The asbestos products with a latex binder such as E-532 (M-5620) and E-530 (M-5642) do not require special labeling.

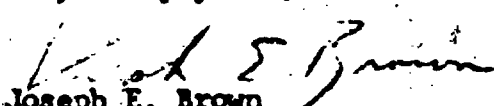
The label will read as follows:

C A U T I O N
CONTAINS ASBESTOS FIBERS
AVOID CREATING DUST
BREATHING ASBESTOS DUST
MAY CAUSE
SERIOUS BODILY HARM
