Our incinerator supply situation looks about like this to me:

1. On Hand	4.2M Lbs.
2. Normal Returns (0.2M Lbs./Mo.)	2.4M Lbs.
3. Goodyear	2.0M Lbs.
4. DCA Residue Committed For	0.9M Lbs.
Total	9.5M Lbs.
Less Nov.-Dec. (pessimistic)	1.0M Lbs.
To Be Disposed of in 1973	8.5M Lbs.

Expected rate in 1973:

$0.7\text{M}/\text{Mo.} \times 12 \times .8 \text{ OST} = 6.7\text{M Lbs.}$

I have recently received a call from Don Mahlandt who sells Maleic Anhydride to Edwin Cooper asking could we incinerate 1.2M lbs. of Maleic waste from the ashless detergent plant next year. If we are going to receive progressively less P.C.B. material to burn, we should address ourselves to the question, "What to burn and how should be charge for our incinerator." I have talked briefly to Paul Gann about what will be returned next year.

I would think we need to get an accurate count on business group needs and then peddle our excess capacity.
