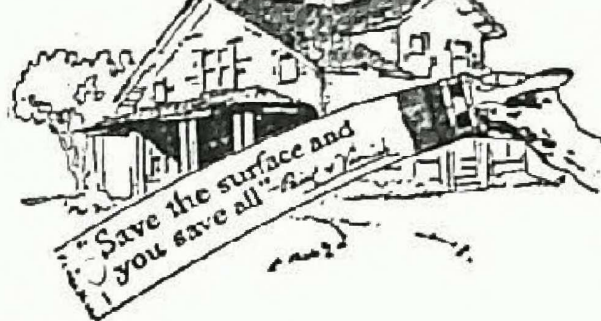

PLAN IS OPPOSED

F. H. Plunkett, assistant director of traffic of the Southern Pacific lines, declared that in June, 1917, the relief from the provisions of the long and short-haul clause on westbound transcontinental traffic was withdrawn by the commission because ships which had been using the canal route abandoned that service and were put into overseas traffic resulting from the war.

The Interstate Commerce Commission in 1918, he declared, granted permission to the Southern Pacific to equalize the New York-to-California water and rail rates with the Chicago and California all-rail wages. War conditions, he said, caused this equalization to be cancelled before it was put into effect.

The equalization of New York-to-California and the Chicago-to-California rates would be a severe blow to Middle West shippers and manufacturers, Luther M. Walter, representing some of the opponents, declared today. "Should the proposed rates be granted, they would be discriminatory," he said further that such rates as Detroit and other Middle West points would be virtually eliminated from the Pacific Coast trade.

SHOWS DIFFERENCE

"It is a mistake to say," Mr. Plunkett said, "that the Southern Pacific's policy was to carry the Chicago rates from New York, the actual fact being that it was the policy of the rail lines from Chicago, including the Southern Pacific's rail lines, and their connections to carry the water competition New York rates from Chicago."

Japanese Park Not Dangerous, Say Army Men

The War Department yesterday dropped its inquiry of the project to establish a Japanese pleasure resort near Fort MacArthur, Los Angeles Harbor, said a dispatch last night from Washington. Secretary of War Weeks said the special board of Army officers assigned to look into the question had reported that the project in no wise would endanger the coastal defense at Los Angeles. The text of their report was not made public.

California members of Congress had urged the inquiry in response to complaints from home.
