Subject: Invoice for Talc Analysis

An invoice for professional services rendered by Environmental Health Laboratories is attached. This invoice covers analysis of a sample of talc powder submitted by Dearborn Glass Plant to determine the fibrous talc content (asbestos). The percentage of fibrous talc in this sample was 38 percent.

We have arranged with H. Breniser, Safety Engineer, DGP, to evaluate employee exposures to dust of this material with respect to OSHA asbestos exposure regulations. The nature of the dry spray application of this powder in Department 92 by several employees to glass panels indicates potentially excessive exposures.

If this powder is used at Nashville Glass Plant, we recommend samples be sent to this office for analysis. We also request this invoice be forwarded to the appropriate Glass Division accounting facility.
