

1 I was involved, the brake lining industry, which used
2 strictly chrysotile. So that's where I got the opinion that
3 there was a safe level for operating with the asbestos.

4 Q And that opinion was specific to include the
5 disease mesothelioma?

6 A No.

7 MR. FRIESTEDT: Objection.

8 A I was -- no.

9 Q Okay. Did you ever discuss mesothelioma with Dr.
10 Selikoff?

11 A No, I don't believe so.

12 Q How about Dr. Nicholson?

13 A I doubt it.

14 Q To help orient us to the discussions you had with
15 Dr. Selikoff, I would like to draw your attention to a
16 handwritten memo to you dated January 27, 1976, from Arthur
17 Roul. If I could hand you this and ask you to look at it,
18 see if that refreshes your recollection of the time period
19 when you were interacting with Dr. Selikoff.

20 A I was going to say after I talked with Selikoff or
21 what. I don't remember this specific one. Was this sent to
22 me? Dear Mr. Drislane, Dr. Selikoff asked me to send you the
23 results of our asbestos fiber counts during brake repair
