81-8688 DULUX® HI-GLOSS ENAMEL

Milford Rivet and Machine Company, Milford, Conn., called Du Pont on May 5 to determine content of subject paint. Dr. Zapp's secretary asked me to call Mr. Mitchellson at Milford.

He said that an employee had used 81-8688 and claimed the lead in it made him sick. Mr. Mitchellson wanted to know lead content. We advised him that this product contained no lead.

Upon receipt of an updated formula breakdown on May 11, 1972, I called Mr. Mitchellson and advised that paint formula calls for 0.32% lead (as a drier). He said he thought they had resolved their problem with no trouble.
