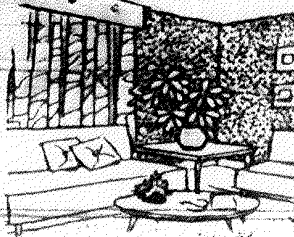

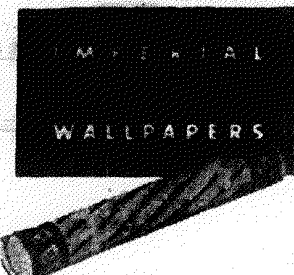

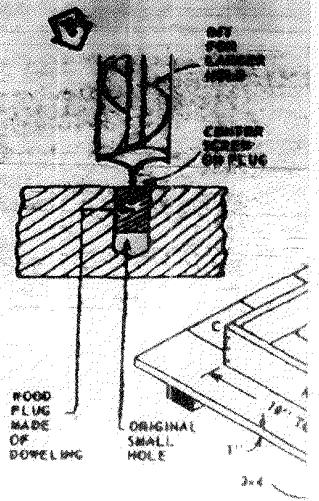

Plugs And

Readers meet difficulties when they use an ordinary bit to enlarge a hole in wood. The bit is hard to get started in the right place so the desired hole will have the same center as the original smaller hole.

Picture X shows a cross section of a small hole in a piece of wood. For example, the hole must be enlarged to dimension A to B. A drill bit will usually slide from side to side and ruin the wood surface.

The solution is to drive a piece of doweling or other wood whittled to proper size into the original hole as shown in picture Y. The plug must make a tight fit, and its top surface should be flush with the surface of the board. Carefully center the screw of the bit on the plug, as indicated in picture Y, and a new enlarged hole can be drilled without difficulty.

FLAGSTONES EASILY MADE

Now is the time of the year when homemakers consider building patio areas and new walks. Natural flagstones can be used with pleasing results, or artificial stones can be made using simple wood forms, cement and sand.

Picture Z shows a square form made with 2x4 wood stock. The shape of the form may of course be varied. It is advisable not to make the form larger than fourteen inches square, or long, because of difficulties in handling heavy casts as well as possible breakage.

Picture Z shows the form placed on a wood platform made of 2x4's and 1x4 or 1x5-inch boards. Use one pail of portland cement and three pails of clean, sharp sand which has irregular shapes and is not rounded in any respect. Use only enough water to make the mix plastic and easy to mold. Too much water lessens the strength of the mix.
