May	Fire Extinguishers (Safety to Schedule for all employees)
June	Forklift Operations (All operations and maintenance)
July	Hand Safety & Fall Protection / Ladder Safety (All operations, maintenance, lab, and engineering)
August	Ergonomics (All employees)
September	Lockout / Tagout (All employees except office personnel)

October Plant Emergency Procedures (All employees)

November Hazcom / MSDS's (All employees)

December Winter Safety (All employees)
