My dear Warren:-

I have your favor of the 25th ult. Recently received fountain pencils and returned them to manufacturers. Note your request for figures of Pure Prepared and Phoenix picturesque cottages finished with crystalloid. On Jan. 19th I wrote you quoting price received from Whitehead & Hoag Co. I enclose copy of this letter in case you cannot find it. Meek & Co. recently sent a man down to see me and he talked so much about the difficulties in handling the prints you sent me, I certainly agree with you they are very unlikely to make a good job of it. I have taken up the matter with other parties and will let you have quotations soon.

I held up the White Enamel Varnish so as to forward both samples with other goods. You ought to receive them soon. Will obtain samples of Zinc from Gabriel & Schall.

Mr. Somers told me to-day he would positively submit match for the Harrison #1793 Vermilion to-morrow. He will also submit ^{duplicate} samples of their own Fast Reds at the same
