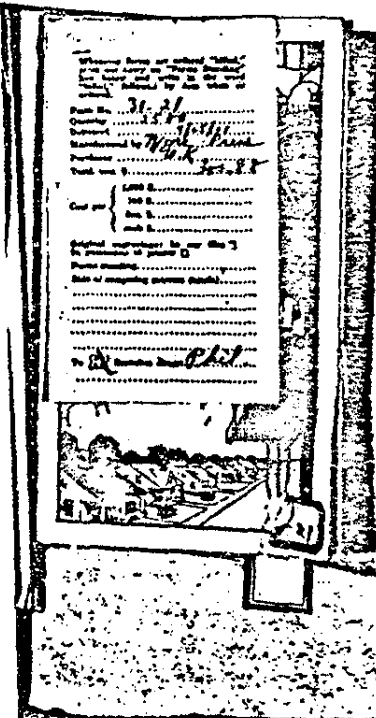


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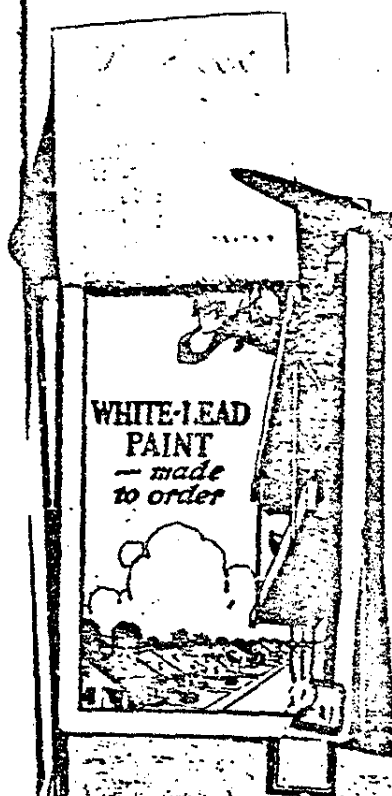

Pure white-lead paint for exterior use is made by thinning paste white-lead to painting consistency with pure linseed oil and adding turpentine and drier. This gives a white paint which produces a glossy finish. For interior painting, where a glossless or flat finish is preferred, the paste white-lead is thinned with flaxing oil. In either case, tinting matter is added to the white paint if a colored paint is desired.

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It is customary for the painter to obtain the various materials separately and to mix them into paint as required. While most users still prefer to have their painters mix the paint to order, there are some who want their paint in ready-to-use form. "It saves time," they tell us. If you are one of the latter, you will be interested in the following special offer.

Ready to Put On

The paint you order will be shipped in cans or barrels, whichever you prefer.

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use only Lewis paint materials—white-lead, linseed oil, flattening oil, colors—all doubly guaranteed as to excellence by the Lewis name and our well-known Dutch Boy trademark.

Exterior Paint

If you order white paint for exterior use, you will receive pure white-lead paint made of Lewis white-lead, Lewis linseed oil, pure turpentine and driers—nothing else. If you order colored paint for exterior use, you will get the same composition exactly to which only Lewis colors have been added to give the desired tint or shade.

Pure white-lead paint so made dries to a lasting, high gloss and insures real surface protection—

the kind which has preserved for us the many fine examples of Colonial architecture which are still in prime condition to-day. Moreover, such a paint wears down without crack or scale, requiring no expensive scraping or burning to smooth down the surface when repainting becomes necessary. Just dust off and repaint.

Interior Paint

If you want a fast paint for interior use, we will make it of Lewis white-lead and flattening oil. We can leave the paint white or tint it with Lewis colors to suit your taste.

One of the outstanding advantages of made-to-order paint (flat or gloss), is that you are not confined to stock colors.

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We can match any tint no matter how uncommon or delicate.

Like Adding Windows

Using flat paint such as we offer you, either white or in a light color, on interiors, is like adding more windows. Lightness is increased, the light being thoroughly diffused and more evenly distributed. There is no glare. Spotty illumination is eliminated. Spoilage is less, accidents are fewer, production is greater in properly lighted mills.

A Washable Paint

Surfaces painted with flat paint composed of Lewis white-lead and flaking oil can be cleaned as often as necessary with soap and water without injury to the finish. Washing

restores the freshness of the original finish, saving the cost of a repainting which would otherwise be necessary.

Fifty Per Cent Greater Spread

In having your flat paint made to order by us, you will not pay any more for it but you will get a flat paint which will cover fifty per cent more surface per gallon than most. Moreover, the paint will not chip, peel or scale, no matter how great the vibration in your mill.

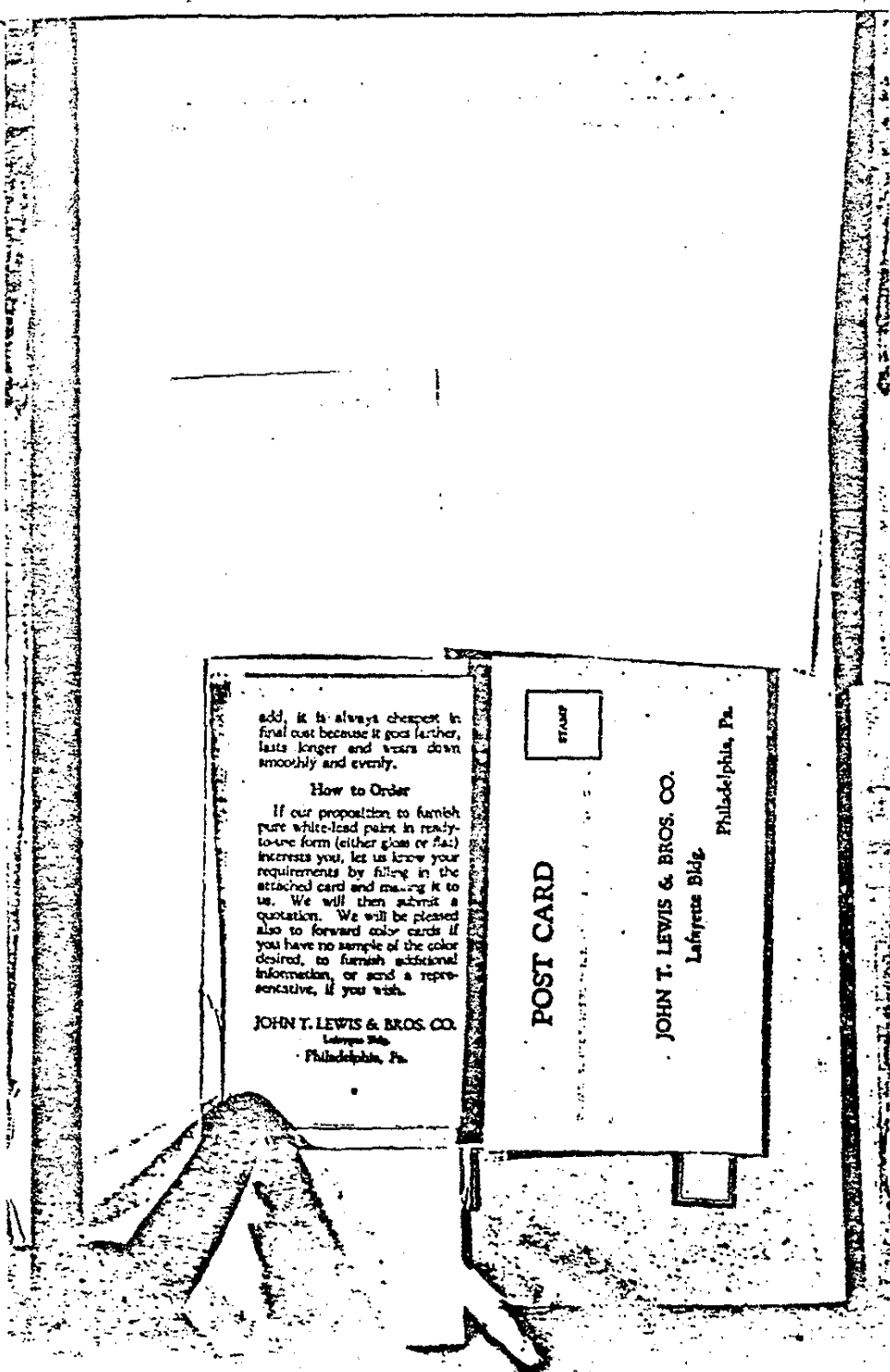
