Enclosed is our permit to dispose of your material, which may be contaminated with PCB.

Your cost is \$.06 per pound F.O.B. our site, approximately 10 miles west of Grand View, ID 83624. (shipping address)

We are limited by the regulations in the Federal Register of February 17, 1978 part V titled "Polychlorinated Biphenyls - Disposal and Marking". The federal register explains your packaging and shipping procedure as well as the restrictions on disposal.

We suggest that your company ship all the authorized material that you have on hand immediately, in order to avoid more stringent government regulations in the future.

Another more serious and insidious reason for rushing the material to us is that we are "getting ideas" about nudging our prices up just a hair.
